### **The Marketing Management Programme 2011 - 2013**

#### **Please read this carefully, before applying for admission**

Please notice that we start new classes in September only and that the next session will start September 2011. The deadline for receiving applications for the academic session 201 - 2013 is March 15, 2011. However you are welcome to send your application already now. We will evaluate your application as soon, as we get it.

Please notice that The Marketing Management Programme is not a Bachelor programme, it is a 2-year programme at a university level. After graduation the students may attend our own 1½ year bachelor top up programme. Also the study credits obtained through the programme are transferable to a number of partner-universities in Denmark or abroad.

Applicants from outside Western Europe must in most cases have a TOEFL-test or an IELTS -test (contact Mr Lars Host-Madsen on [laho@tietgen.dk](mailto:laho@tietgen.dk)). For foreigners already living in Denmark we arrange our own English test.

#### **Fee structure and other financial aspects:**

**For students from EU-countries or Nordic countries, the tuition is free of charge. Also for foreigners with a permanent residence permit the tuition is free of charge.**

**Due to regulations from the Danish Ministry of Education, all higher education programmes must charge tuition fees from applicants coming from outside the EU-countries/Nordic countries.**

Tuition fee: The annual tuition fee is 8.700 EURO = DKK 65,000 (6 DKK = approximately 1 USD)

Terms of payment for 2011/2012:

- 4.350 EURO ( NB! 2010 prices) must be paid within 3 weeks, after you have received the provisional acceptance letter, but no later than June 1. When you have paid this first instalment, we will send you the final acceptance letter, which you need in order to apply for a visa to Denmark. As it takes 3 months or even more to get a visa, it is important to pay as early as possible. We help you

through the visa application process, as we have a hotline to the Danish Immigration Service.

- 4.350 EURO must be paid no later than one week prior to the spring semester start.

Living costs: The monthly living costs in Denmark, including books for your studies, are approximately DKK 4,700.

Books: Paying students get books from the college. Other students buy their books themselves. The costs are approximately DKK 5,000 – 6,000 in total over the 2 years.

Work-permit: Non EU students are only allowed to work 15 hours per week and full time in the 3 summer months June, July and August. The salary for a student's free-time job is approximately 100DKK.

#### **New Scholarship possibility for non EU students:**

The Danish Government has launched a new scholarship programme for non EU citizens.

There are only very few scholarships available and a scholarship can consist of tuition fees or a part of tuition fees paid in combination with a monthly amount for living expenses.

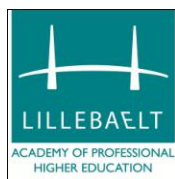
